1 Dunrobin Castle - Resembling a French chateau, Dunrobin has been home to the Dukes of Sutherland since the 1600s. Visit the Clan Sutherland room which contains genealogical records.



2 Cullooden - Explore the atmospheric battlefield where the 1745 Jacobite cause met its bloody end. The visitor centre and interactive exhibition brings the battle vividly to life.



3 Highland Folk Museum - Discover the home and working lives of your Highland ancestors at this award-winning and interactive living history museum.



4 Rob Roy's Grave - Balquhittern Churchyard is the last resting place of Robert Macgregor, the 18th-century outlaw made famous by Sir Walter Scott and, more recently, by Hollywood.



5 Scotland's People Centre - Researching your Scottish roots? Visit the centre at General Register House to tap into almost 500 years of birth, marriage, death and census records.



6 World Pipe Band Championship - Whether you're a bagpipe aficionado or just fancy a great day out, the 3,000 pipers and drummers competing in the 'Worlds' provide a fantastic spectacle of music and colour.



7 Cowal Highland Games - One of the world's largest and most spectacular Highland Games, annually attracts more than 20,000 visitors and over 3,500 competitors to compete in dancing, piping, heavy events, athletics and shinty.



8 Glencoe - Glencoe is infamous as the scene of the Massacre which sparked the historic feud between the Campbell and MacDonald clans. The award-winning visitor centre tells this story and more.



9 Glenfinnan Monument - An area steeped in history, this quiet spot at the head of Loch Shiel is where Bonnie Prince Charlie first rallied the Highland clans for the ill-fated 1745 Jacobite Rebellion.



10 Clan Donald Skye - This 20,000-acre Highland estate built on the traditional lands of Clan Donald on the Skye peninsula, boasts beautiful gardens and the Museum of the Isles.
