Melissa is a teacher and choreographer who has worked across the United States in ballet and modern dance. She holds a B.A. in Dance Education from Jacksonville University in Jacksonville, Florida where she performed in numerous classical and contemporary dance pieces and worked with numerous guest artists including Christian Von Howard, Winifred Jamieson, and Jennifer Blake. While in University, she also taught and choreographed for the University's youth dance program, Dance with Distinction as well as at various Performing Arts schools around Jacksonville.

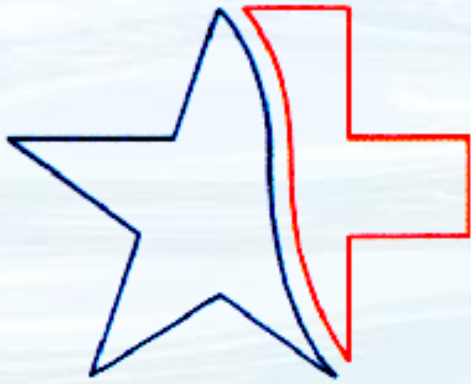
Melissa is originally from Denver, Colorado where she began her dance training and danced with the Arvada Civic Ballet Company performing soloist roles in *Paquita*, *Sleeping Beauty*, *Hansel and Gretel* and *Spirit Dog*. She also trained at Ballet Oklahoma, performing in their annual production of *The Nutcracker* and attended Burklyn Ballet Theatre. At Burklyn Ballet Theatre she worked with Amanda McEerrow, David Howard, Angela Whitehill, Thom Clower, Julia K. Gleich, Joanne Whitehill, Alexander Bennett, Patricia Brewer-Jones, Arthur Leeth and Cherie Noble and performed in numerous classical and contemporary dance works.

In addition to *The Water Project*, Melissa just completed a two-week Residency at Dance Ireland where she taught the Morning Professional classes for a week and participated in *New Movements* in which she presented the choreographic work she created during the residency. She also returned to Colorado in August and created a new dance piece for the Arvada Center Dance Theater.



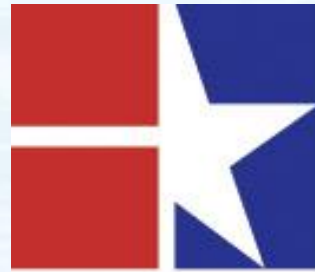
