Keukenhof Gardens

Every spring, hundreds of thousands of flower lovers flock to view this wonderful display of color and scent. The Keukenhof is one of the largest flower gardens in the world. Each year, seven million flower bulbs are planted and cultivated into beautiful gardens, covering 32 hectares of land. Wander the park and experience springtime in all its glory. This offering is for transportation to the Keukenhof Gardens for ½ day. Once there, you will be able to explore the grounds at your leisure and take as many photographs as you would like.

Guided Tour of Delft & Gouda Tuesday, March 27 - 9am to 3pm €65







During this excursion, we will take you to Delft, where you will receive a private tour of the Royal Delft Pottery factory. This factory is one of the only remaining 32 royal factories that were established in Delft in the 17th century. Watch and learn as artisans create new pieces of this beautiful local craft.
