

## Hope Beyond Displacement: Project Update - November 2017

- Super Girls
  - The Educational Consultant is working to finish and hand off the full Super Girls curriculum, working with the program volunteers to make tweaks and updates based on feedback and observations of the daily sessions.
- Women's Empowerment Training
  - The highlight of this month was the completion of the first sessions of both Women's Empowerment 101 and Gender-Based Violence Awareness and Prevention courses. At a small celebration, CRP's Executive Director presented each participant with a certificate of completion.
- ICDL Technical Training
  - Students were given a computer skills assessment to gauge their current level of skill, in order to better inform lesson planning as well as to provide a baseline to measure growth and learning as the class progresses.
  - The instructor reports high levels of engagement and interaction, across all students regardless of prior computer skill and knowledge levels, with a specific interest in Microsoft Excel and how to use spreadsheets.
- Hair and Beauty Training
  - Hair and Beauty Training continues to be one of CRP's most popular programs, with students rarely if ever missing a session.
