

## Project Update - October 2018

- Super Girls
  - On October 6, the SuperGirls visited the Jordan Museum where they learned about the Levante's rich culture and history. The girls loved exploring the museum and learning about history.
  - SuperGirls had a graduation on October 20. The 40 girls held an art gallery, where they showed their parents drawings, paintings, and model mud houses. The girls also did storytelling and a yoga demonstration for their parents. There was a question and answer session, where the girls were able to ask questions about the topics they learned. Each girl received a graduation certificate and a gift bag at the graduation
  - ▶ A new session of SuperGirls started on October 23, with the volunteer training taking place on October 22.
- ICDL Technical Training
  - Two ICDL classes were offered in October and each class had 15 women attend. The women learned about the basics of computers in October. A graduation for ICDL happened on October 25 that saw six women pass the ICDL exam. These women are grateful to FAWCO for providing funds for them to take the exam.
- Hair and Beauty Training
  - There are 30 women in the two Beauty School classes. In October, the women have learned threading and skin cleansing and treatment, using wax and facial masks.
- Women's Empowerment Training
  - There have been over 20 women attending Women's Empowerment 101. The women learned self-care, leadership and communication skills, and mindfulness techniques to help with psychosocial experiences.
  - Around 17 men and boys have been attending GBV Awareness and Advocacy program. The class has discussed gender roles and emotional intelligence in October.
  - ▶ Both the Women's Empowerment 101 and GBV Awareness and Advocacy programs will have graduations on November 1.
