One participant shared that because of the program she was able to solve problems in her family earlier because she feels more confident to take action.

- The Leadership in Action group spent the month meeting almost daily to finish planning their advocacy events. The first event was on September 24 at a local community-based organization in southern Amman. The event provided the 100 children with disabilities that attended an opportunity to relax and make new friends, as well as learn more about personal hygiene through a play and lecture participants organized.
